WHAT is the Church?

- "Upon this rock I will build my church..." –
 Matt. 16:18
- The church (ekklēsia) is the people of God, those redeemed by Christ
- "There is one body..." Eph. 4:4; 1:22-23
- Why are there so many in the world?

Predictions and warnings

- "in later times some will fall away from the faith..." 1 Tim. 4:1-3
- "savage wolves...men will arise, speaking perverse things" – Acts 20:28-30
- "there will also be false teachers" 2 Pet. 2:1
- "itching ears" 2 Tim. 4:1-4



WHY There Came To Be So Many

Tendencies in the early church

- Teaching the precepts of men Matt. 15:9
- Following men, not Christ 1 Cor. 1:10-13
- Carnal attitudes 1 Cor. 3:1-4
- Philosophies and traditions of men Col. 2:8



WHAT Should We Do?

- Preach the word 2 Tim. 4:2
- Contend for the common faith and common salvation – Jude 3
- Edify the church for spiritual maturity Eph. 4:11-16



The One Church

As Taught in Ephesians



Three Dimensions

- Upward Relationship With God
- Inward Relationship With One Another
- Outward Relationship With the World



Our *Upward* Relationship **With God**

- The Church and the Godhead (1:3-14)
- The fullness of Christ (1:22-23)
- Saved, redeemed by Christ (2:1-10)
- God's eternal purpose (3:11)
- To give God the glory (3:21)



Our *Inward* Relationship With One Another

- Edification of the Body (4:1-16)
- Attitudes that preserve unity (4:1-6)
- Edifying conduct (4:20-29)
- Marriage principles (5:22-23)



Our *Outward* Relationship With The World

- "Saints" (1:1)
- Walk "no longer as the Gentiles" (4:17-20)
- Abstain from what is not "proper among saints" (5:3-5)
- Bride of Christ to be holy (5:26-27)
