Hebrews 6:6b...

- since they again crucify to themselves the Son of God and put Him to open shame (NASB 2020)
- since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding him up to contempt (ESV)
- since on their own they are crucifying again the Son of God and are holding him up to contempt (NRSV)
- It is impossible to bring them back to a changed life again, because they are nailing the Son of God to a cross again and are shaming him in front of others (NCV)
- since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame (NKJV)
