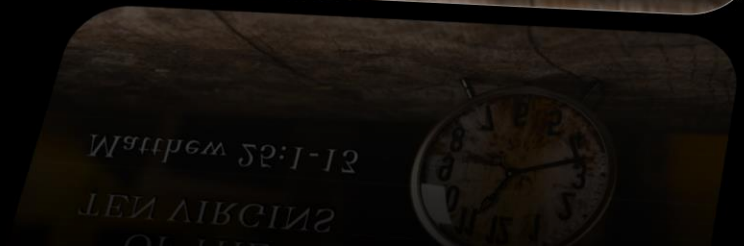

- People are like the virgins waiting for the bridegroom

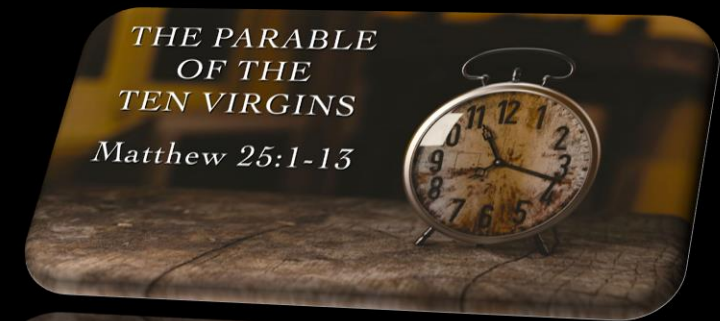
Some are WISE

The Parable Of Ten Virgins

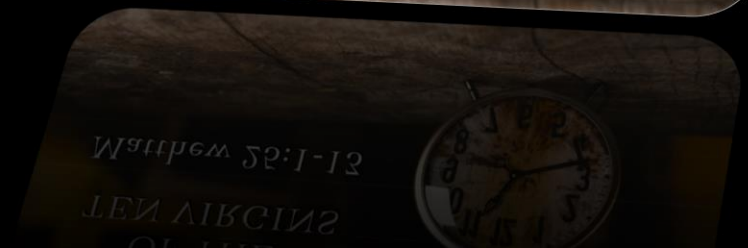

- Most people think a little is all they need

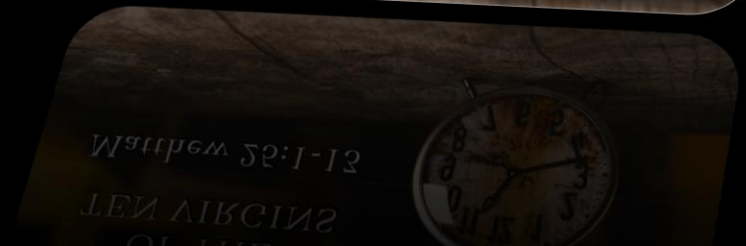
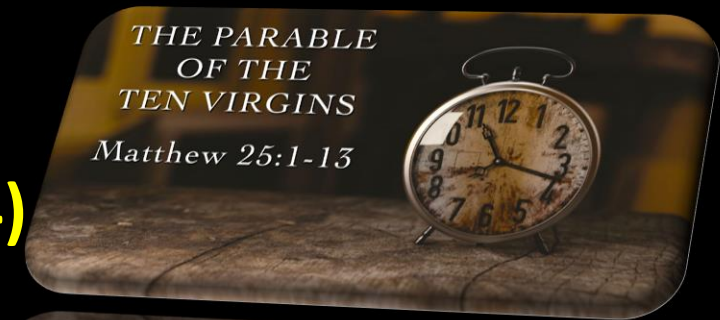
The five foolish had SOME oil

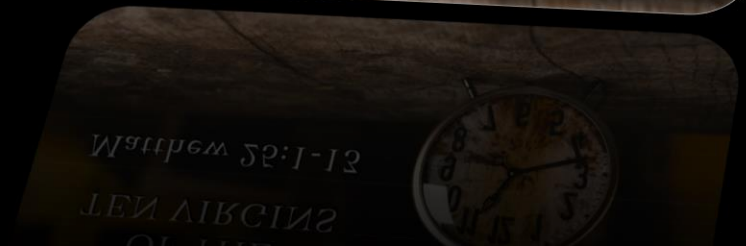
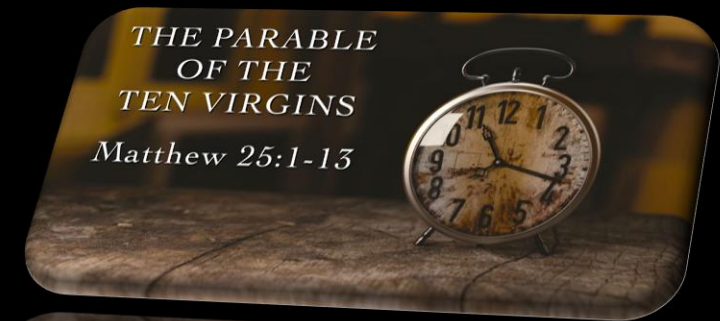


The Parable Of Ten Virgins
