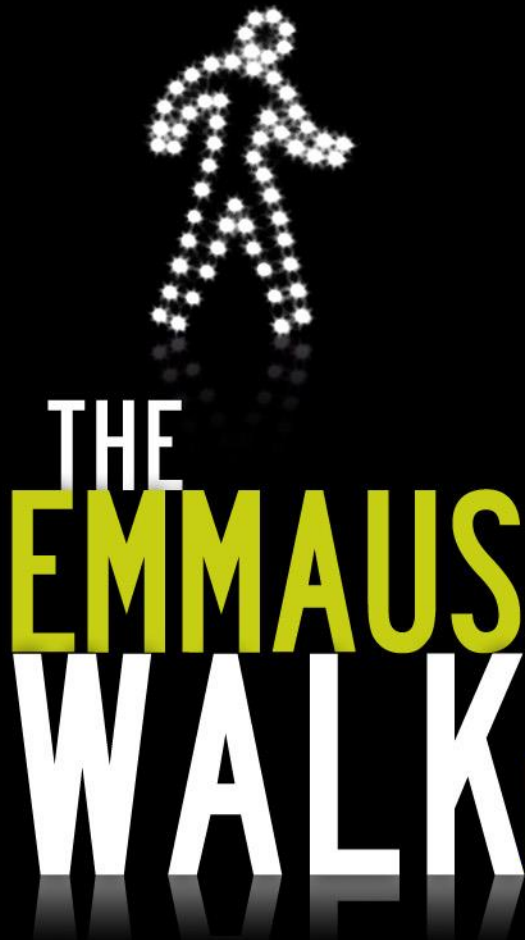
He spoke as one of THEM!
