Sharing in similarities Hebrews 2:14-15 (p 1374) **Christ fellowshipped** 1 John 1:1-7 (p 1398) **Spiritual participation** Philemon 6 (p 1371) **Sharing of your faith Working Partners** Luke 5:7 (p 1185) Partners in an enterprise 2 Corinthians 8:23 (p 1332) Titus is a partner Philippians 1:5; 4:14-15 (pp 1348/1351) Shared FELLOWSHIP

There is only ONE place where FELLOWSHIP is connected with Christian's eating together! 1 Corinthians 10:16 (p 1318) Communion; fellowship, communicate (v14) Fellowship; partnership; participated (v15) The IDEA is found in *Hebrews* 10:24-25 (p 1381) Assembling; meeting together for a common cause

### FELLOWSHIP

#### There is NEGATIVE use of the idea of FELLOWSHIP!

2 Corinthians 6:14-16 (p 1330)

Ephesians 5:8-11 (p 1346)

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. <u>Walk</u> as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. And have <u>no fellowship</u> with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them.

## FELLOWSHIP

Acts 2:42-46 (p 1255)

BUT, SPEAKING THE TRUTH IN LOVE, MAY GROW UP IN ALL THINGS INTO HIM WHO IS THE HEAD— CHRIST — FROM WHOM THE WHOLE BODY, JOINED AND KNIT TOGETHER BY WHAT EVERY JOINT SUPPLIES, ACCORDING TO THE EFFECTIVE WORKING BY WHICH EVERY PART DOES ITS SHARE, CAUSES **GROWTH OF THE BODY FOR THE EDIFYING OF** ITSELF IN LOVE. (EPHESIANS 4:15-16)
