WHAT IS A MEDIATOR

"One who helps negotiate between two feuding parties. From the Latin word 'medius,' which means middle. A mediator is to remain in the neutral middle rather than taking one side over another, in order to help both sides resolve a dispute." (Vocabulary.com)

- Old Testament: yakach (yaw-kahh') to be right, correct; reciprocal, to argue; to decide, justify or convict, maintain, plead, reason together..." (Strongs 03198).
- New Testament: mesites (mes-ee'-tace) a go-between, an internunciator, one who shows or describes someone or something clearly and completely; a reconciler, intercessor (Strongs 3316).

Therefore, a mediator is one who facilitates reconciliation between parties separated by some matter of difference.
