 Aaron loved the Lord God Worship of God is to be HOLY and REVERENT *Leviticus 10:3 (p 121)* BY THOSE WHO COME NEAR ME I MUST BE REGARDED AS

HOLY; AND BEFORE ALL THE PEOPLE I MUST BE GLORIFIED!
