Romans Chapter 8

- We are no longer under any condemnation (v. 1).
- We are set free from the law of sin and death (v. 2).
- Christ did something for us we could not do, condemning sin in His flesh on our behalf (v. 3).
- We can fulfill the law as we walk according to the Spirit (we never had the ability to do this before) (v. 4).
- Our minds are set/directed/focused to the things of the Spirit, and we have the capacity to think in a new realm (v. 5).
- We now have life and peace instead of death (v. 6).
- Our mind is no longer hostile toward God (v. 7).
- We can please God (v. 8).
- We belong to Him (v. 9).
- Our spirit is alive because of righteousness (v. 10).
- His Spirit gives life to our mortal bodies (v. 11).

Romans Chapter 8

- We are under obligation to live by the Spirit, not according to the humanistic flesh (this is a wonderful pressure and can be fulfilled because the Spirit is in us!) (v. 12).
- We live (v. 13)!
- We are led by the Spirit (v. 14).
- We are led by the Spirit (v. 14).
- We are sons of God (v. 14).
- We have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear (v. 15).
- We have received a spirit of adoptions as sons, by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" (v. 15).
- The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God (v. 16).
- Because we are children, we are heirs with God and fellow heirs with Christ (v. 17).

In Christ Romans Chapter 8

- helps our weakness by praying for us, and He does this perfectly because He intercedes for us according to the will of God (v. 27).
- God causes all things to work together for good as we are loving Him and called according to His purpose (v. 28).
- We have a glorious purpose—to become conformed to the image of His Son (v. 29).
- He has foreknown, predestined, called, justified, and glorified us (v. 30)!
- God is for us (so who can possibly stand against us?) (v. 31)!
- He did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us (v. 32).
- He will freely give us all things (v. 32).

Salvation – II Timothy 2:10 (p.1367)

Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

Salvation is only in Christ - Acts 4:12 (p.1256)

Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Eternal Life - 1 John 5:11-12 and Romans 6:23 (p. 1402&1299)

And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The One Way – John 14:6 (p.1241)







- Galatians 3:27 (p.1339) For as many of you were baptized into Christ have put on Christ
- Romans 6:3 (p.1298)

- I Cor 12:13 (p.1320) For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.
- I Cor 12:27 (p. 1321)- Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.
- Rev 14:3 (p.1418) Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.'"
