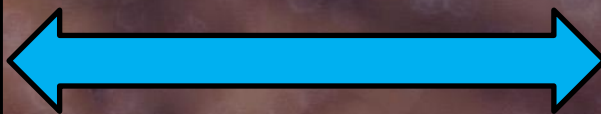



A SOLUTION - (v24)


Body of sin removed	<i>Romans 6:6 (p 1298)</i>


*Enter by the narrow
