
Did Peter Deny The Grace Of God? Acts 12 (p 1268)



## Acts Of The Divine

- An angel appeared to him (v7)
   He was God's messenger
- The chains fell off (v7)


  Impossible for Peter to have done
- Peter leaves without being seen (v 10)
   Unnoticed by 16 trained soldiers (v19)
- Iron gate opens by itself (v 10)
   Not opened by man
- HOW? Verse 17



## Acts Of The Man

- The angel told Peter to "Get up"

  Peter had to get up on his own
- The angel commands Peter to put his clothes on *Peter had to dress himself*
- He was further told to put his shoes on his feet
   Peter had to put his own sandals on
- The angel said, "Follow me"
   Peter obeyed the command
   V9 with Acts 10:9-16 (p 1265)



Peter: How did you get out of prison?
 The Lord delivered me (v7) GRACE OF GOD

Peter: How did the Lord deliver you?
 Well I did this and that WORKS OF MAN
