CONSTANTINE AND THE EDICT OF MILAN AD 313

In AD 606 the Roman emperor took the title of "Universal Bishop" from the Patriarch of Constantinople and conferred it on Boniface III, bishop of Rome.

This was the first Pope and the real beginning of the Roman Catholic Church.
