


Luke 23:39-43 (p 1217)






The Thief: His Story

We know little about the man.

- He was a condemned man.
- Was he a companion of Barabbas?
 Luke 23:25 (p 1216); Mark 15:6-7 (p 1174)
- He knew his punishment was just.
 Luke 23:41 (p 1217)
- He knew something about the kingdom of Christ.
 Luke 23:42 (p 1217)



The Thief: His Story

He reviled Jesus with the other man.

Matthew 27:38-44 (p 1149)

Sometime in the early hours of crucifixion, he changed. Luke 23:33-34 (p 1217)

He believed in the wrath of God!

The Man In The Middle

Jesus was arrested, tried, and condemned to die


Acts 2:22-23 (p 1254)

Jesus died at the hands of those He came to save

Acts 3:13-15 (p 1255)

Jesus never sinned and died a sinless man

Hebrews 4:15 (p 1375)



The Man In The Middle

Jesus proved He was the Son of God with authority

Mark 2:1-12 (p 1152)

- ✓ Jesus forgave the man of his sins (v5)
- ✓ Challenged by scribes (∨7)
- ✓ Jesus poses a question (∨9)
- ✓ Jesus proves His divinity (vv10-12)



IN HIM YOU WERE ALSO CIRCUMCISED WITH THE CIRCUMCISION MADE WITHOUT HANDS, BY PUTTING OFF THE BODY OF THE SINS OF THE FLESH, BY THE CIRCUMCISION OF CHRIST, BURIED WITH HIM IN BAPTISM, IN WHICH YOU ALSO WERE RAISED WITH HIM THROUGH FAITH IN THE WORKING OF GOD, WHO RAISED HIM FROM THE DEAD.
