That which was lost

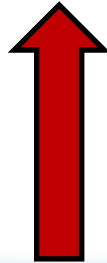

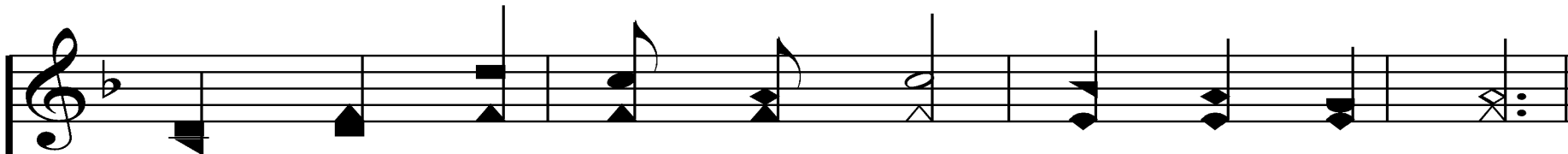
BRING CHRIST YOUR BROKEN LIFE

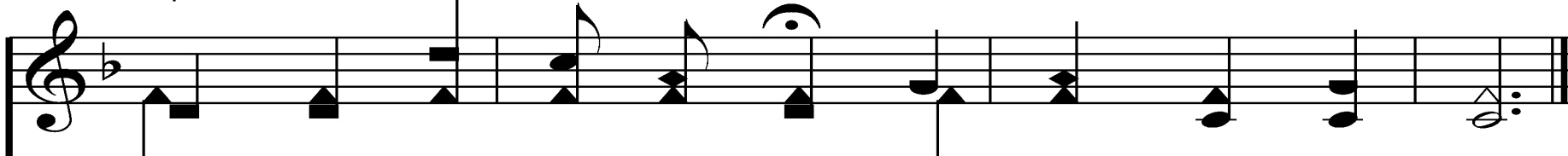
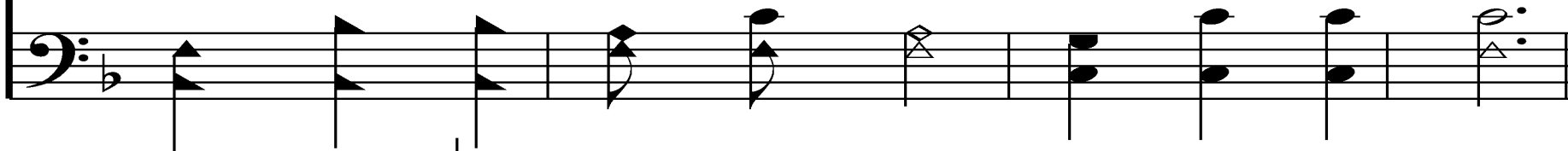
Psalm 38:8-9
