


Romans 12:1-2 (p 1305)

(11) not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;




Romans 12:9-21 (p 1306)

- (15) Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.




Romans 12:9-21 (p 1306)
