
The Supper Of The Lord

The Lord's Supper Paul called this memorial the Lord's (deipnon), a Greek word that referred to a supper of feast and that normally designated the main meal of the day. 1 Corinthians 11:20-34 (p 1319)

The Lord's Supper Each week, observing the Lord's Supper reminds us that Jesus is our spiritual food. John 6:51-54 (p 1229) Life is in the blood Leviticus 17:11-14 (p 132) Human sacrifice reprehensible Jeremiah 19:5 (p 892)

Every Sunday, as we partake of the body and the blood of the Lord, it should be a sober reminder of the magnitude of Jesus' sacrifice and how absolutely vital He is to us. For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (p 1320)
