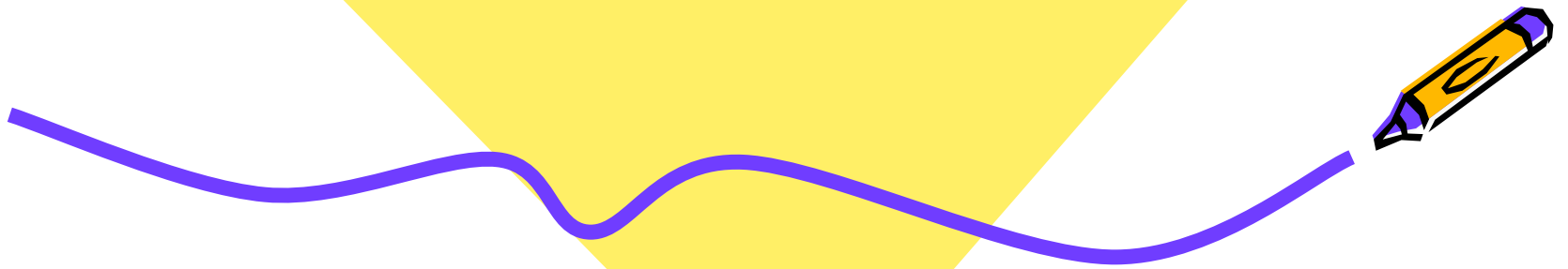

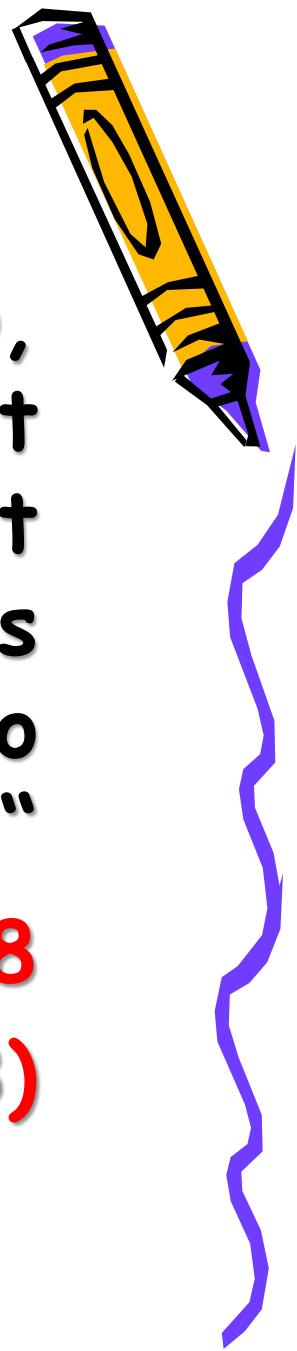

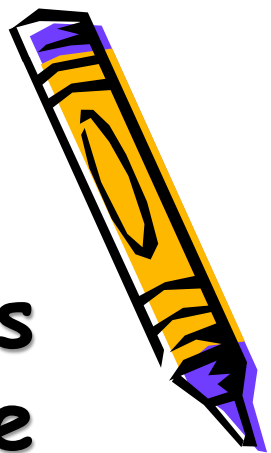
MANOAH
