☑ The army of Israel could not see the cause.
☑ The fear of Goliath clouded their faith.
☑ The intimidation of Goliath led them to do nothing
☑ The enemies of God were victorious

DAVID

"Is there not a cause?" 1 Samuel 17:29

Goliath defied the armies of Israel (17:10)
Goliath reproached God (17:26)
David killed Goliath because of his dishonor to the Lord (17:45-47)

David Saw The CAUSE




