- Galatians 6:1 Consider yourself

HOW DOES JESUS EXPLAIN JUDGING

God does not prohibit all judgment John 7:24 (p 1230)

God does not prohibit discernment Hebrews 5:11-4 (p 1376)

God does not prohibit decision making

Acts 15:19 (p 1273)

Judgment made in discerning dogs

Two kinds of judging:


- 1 Unrighteous: *Luke 18:11-12 (p 1207)*
- 2 Righteous: *John 7:24 (p 1230)*

- ✓ John 8:24 (p 1232)
