


Zacchaeus the MAN verse 2

Zacchaeus the SEEKER verses 3-4


Physical limitation of "short stature"

What are we willing to do for Jesus; how far will we go to see Jesus?




- Zacchaeus the HOST verses 5-6
 Jesus knew his name and wanted to stay with him
 This despised man rejoiced Jesus was coming to his home
- Zacchaeus the SINNER verse 7
 Labeled by others; accepted by Jesus
 Jesus knew the heart of Zacchaeus; the crowd did not



Zacchaeus the RESTORER verse 8
 Repentance demanded action

 He wanted to show everyone Christ in his life

Zacchaeus the SON verse 9
 His life was worthy to bear the name of Abraham
 Our lives must be worthy to bear the name of Christ




