The most common question asked whenever God has not spoken or authorized a particular thing is the WHY CAN'T WE question.

- Why can't we do this thing not mentioned in the Bible?
- Why can't we celebrate Christmas or Easter?
- Why can't we baptize babies?
- Why can't we use instrumental music in worship?

- Permissive answer: You can (are permitted to) do ANY unmentioned thing as long as it is not specifically forbidden in the Bible.
  - As long as God did not say, THOU SHALL NOT!
- Prohibitory answer: The law of exclusion.
  - You cannot do any unmentioned thing.
    - One specific thing forbids the thing(s) not specifically mentioned.
  - The command to sing (Ephesians 5:19), for example, excludes the playing of an instrument in worship to God.

#### THE SILENCE PRINCIPLES FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT

- Israel at the Red Sea Exodus 14:10-14 (p 76)
  - We learn that we must wait for God's answer or speech to permit us to do the thing under consideration.
  - Wait for God's answer not our presumption on God's answer.
- How long to wait?

ACTING WITHOUT PERMISSION - AND NOT WAITING.
WE WILL SOON FORGET THE NEED FOR GOD'S PERMISSION IN ANYTHING!

#### THE SILENCE PRINCIPLES FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT

- Sabbath violation Numbers 15:32-36 (p171)
  - Could they act themselves since God did not say?
    - Instead, they waited for the word of the Lord.
    - Moses did not speak until he inquired of the Lord!
  - They did not presume on the answer or jump to conclusions without the authority of the word of God.

#### THE SILENCE PRINCIPLES FROM THE NEW TESTAMENT

- Peter established the principle of authority 1 Peter 4:11 (p 1393)
  - NASB "utterances"
  - NIV "the very words of God"

WHERE THE BIBLE SPEAKS, WE SPEAK; WHERE THE BIBLE IS SILENT, WE ARE SILENT!

Silence does not authorize action; only God's spoken revelation does!
