Jesus dies *Matthew 27:45-50*




Joseph of Arimathea Matthew 27:57-61 (p 1149)

They agree to be bribed Matthew 28:11-15 (p 1150)


Penalty for losing a prisoner Acts 12:19 (p 1269)

THE PROBLEM WITH THE BODY OF JESUS

- 2. The Jews would not dare to steal the body.
- 3. The Romans would have no desire to steal the body of Jesus.





Acts 2:36-39
