DAVID AND GOLIATH

1 Samuel 17 (p 330)

David's View Of The Problem – verses 23-27 He recognized the need to stop Goliath. He was upset that no one had tried to defeat Goliath Because of fear, the army of God cowered in their tents When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were dismayed and greatly afraid. (v11) And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, fled from him and were dreadfully afraid. (v24)

Eliab's View Of David – verses 28-29 Eliab tried to discourage David Critical of David for being there Finding fault with others is easy to do Eliab had no confidence in David David did not let criticism stop his CAUSE Eliab had lost sight of the power of God.

David's View Of God – verses 31-37

David had history with God, and he knew the power of God There was a power living in the heart of David Trusting in the Lord today requires learning to trust in Him in our yesterdays to have courage to face our tomorrows David believed in the deliverance of God **GO AND THE LORD BE WITH YOU!**

David's View Of Human Wisdom – verses 38-39

The armor of Saul did not fit the boy David nor the man of faith David

Relying on the weapons of men cannot save David realized the power to defeat Goliath came from the power of God – not men!

Goliath needed to be measured by God David had not tested the armor!

David's View Of Goliath – verses 40-47

It took courage for David to walk into the valley of Elah David came in the name of the Lord David believed there was only one true God David trusted in the army of God David's view of Goliath was that he was so big how could he miss?

David ran towards Goliath!!!!

So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone and struck the Philistine and killed him. But there was no sword in the hand of David. Therefore, David ran and stood over the Philistine, took his sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him, and cut off his head with it. And when the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they fled. (vv 50-51)
