The Work Of The Church

“Church” used in three senses

1. Universal – all those called out of the world into the kingdom *Matthew 16:18 (p 1131); Ephesians 1:22-23 (p 1343)*
2. Local – all those called out in a definite locality *1 Cor. 1:2 (p 1310); Acts 15:22 (p 1273); Romans 16:16 (p 1309)*
3. An assembly of people      Unruly mob      *Acts 19:32 (p 1280)*      City council      *Acts 19:39 (p 1280)*  
   An assembly of saints      *1 Corinthians 11:18 (p 1319); 1 Corinthians 14:35 (p 1323)*

God established the \_\_\_\_\_ CHURCH as the only collective medium through which early Christians worked!
