#1. Commit to maintain integrity.

"Make every effort to be found spotless, blameless, and at peace with Him" (2 Peter 3:14).

#2. Commit to forgive those who hurt you.

"Make every effort to live in peace with all men. See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up" (Heb 12:14-15).

#3. Commit to relax and trust God.

"Anyone who enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from His. Let us therefore make every effort to enter into God's rest" (Heb 4:11).

#4. Commit to be an encourager.

"Let us make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification" (Romans 14:19).

#5. Commit to be a peacemaker!

"Make every effort to keep the unity of the spirit though the bond of peace" (Eph 4:3).

#5. Commit to be a peacemaker!

- •Unity is not optional but expected.
- •Unity is *expected* but is *difficult*.
- •Unity is difficult but worth the effort.

#6. Commit to never stop growing!

"Make every effort to add your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge, and to knowledge, self-control, and to self-control, perseverance, and to perseverance, godliness, and to godliness, brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness, love."

"For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being *ineffective and unproductive*" (2 Peter 1:5-8).
