- ✓ Gifts of H. S. – **1 Corinthians 12:10 (p 1320)**  
*Gift of miracles*

- ✓ Samuel raised – 1 Samuel 28:11-12 (p 345)
- ✓ Widow's son – 1 Kings 17:17-24 (p 411) Elijah
- ✓ Daughter of Jairus – Matthew 9:23-26 (p 1120)
- ✓ Apostles given power – Matthew 10:8 (p 1121)

## Romans 6:1-7 (p 1298)

Teaches The Necessity Of RESURRECTION!

- V3 Baptized into Christ is baptized into His death
- V4 Baptism – burial in water; Jesus buried in tomb
- V4 Resurrection comes after the burial; not before
- V5 No resurrection = no salvation





## Romans 6:1-7 (p 1298)

Teaches The Necessity Of RESURRECTION!

Vv 6-7      knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin.
