- ✓ Isaiah Isaiah 26:19 (p 811) "dead shall live"
- ✓ Ezekiel Ezekiel 37 (p 1001) "dry bones"

- ✓ Samuel raised 1 Samuel 28:11-12 (p 345)
- ✓ Widow's son 1 Kings 17:17-24 (p 411) Elijah
- ✓ Daughter of Jairus Matthew 9:23-26 (p 1120)
- ✓ Apostles given power Matthew 10:8 (p 1121)

- ✓ Lazarus John 11:43-44 (p 1236)
- ✓ Dorcas Acts 9:36-42 (p 1265)
- ✓ Eutychus Acts 20:8-10 (p 1280)

EVERYONE DIED AGAIN!!!

The greatest resurrection was Jesus Christ, but it is not the most important!

He died, was buried, and rose again the third day 1 Corinthians 15:3-8 (p 1323)

Others arose after Jesus arose from the dead Matthew 27:51-53 (p 1149)



What makes the resurrection of Jesus significant is that He rose and has never died again.

But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God, and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!" Acts 7:55-56 (p 1262)





Romans 6:1-7 (p 1298)

Teaches The Necessity Of RESURRECTION!


- V3 Baptized into Christ is baptized into His death
- V4 Baptism burial in water; Jesus buried in tomb
- V4 Resurrection comes after the burial; not before
- V5 No resurrection = no salvation

Romans 6:1-7 (p 1298)

Teaches The Necessity Of RESURRECTION!

Vv 6-7 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin.
